



Dependent Resurvey of the North Boundary of T. 1 N., R. 26 W.,
as Resurveyed by Henry Wells, Deputy Surveyor, in 1851.

Chains	
	From the closing cor. of Secs. 1 N., Rs. 25 and 26 W., which is an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., in a cylindrical concrete monument, 10 ins. diam., set, marked, and witnessed as described in the official record.
	N. 88° 48' W., bet. secs. 1 and 36.
	Over rolling land, through cut-over pine and black-jack oak timber.
18.36	Enter a titi swamp, bears NE. and SW.
34.30	Proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original post or bearing trees.
	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., upper portion encased in concrete, 30 ins. long, 6 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,

	A longleaf pine, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 52° W., 33 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 36 E T
	A longleaf pine, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 51° W., 77 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 E T
49.46	The east fork of a bayou, 75 lks. wide, 5 feet deep. Enter Yellow River swamp.
51.56	The west fork of the same bayou, 150 lks. wide, 8 ft. deep.
74.36	The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35, and 36, which is a cypress tree, 60 ins. diam., scribed, but marks illegible, the tree was remarked,
	T 2 N R 26 W S 36, on NE.,
	T 1 N R 26 W S 1, on SE.,
	T 1 N R 26 W S 2, on SW., and
	T 2 N R 26 W S 35, on NW. side.
	Land, low swamp with deep water and mud. Soil, muck, 3rd rate. Timber, cypress, gum, oak, ash, bay, and juniper.
	N. 88° 59' W., bet. secs. 2 and 35.
	Through dense swamp with deep water and mud; timber, cypress, juniper, wateroak, gum, and ash.
10.25	The left bank of Yellow River, 8 ft. deep, course SW.; there is no remaining evidence of the original post or bearing trees of the original meander corner.
	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for the meander cor. of frac. secs. 2 and 35, on the left bank of Yellow River, with brass cap mkd.,
