
RESURVEY PLAT. of a portion of T. 37 S.,R. 29 E.,Tall. Mer., FLORIDA.

MEMORANDUM

This plat of the resurvey of a portion of T. 37 S., R. 29 E., delineates a retracement and reestablishment of the lines of the original survey as shown upon the plat approved May 31, 1870, in their true original position according to the best available evidence of the position of the original corners; all differences between the measurements shown on the original plat and those derived in the retracement have been distributed proportionally between accepted corners in accordance with surveying rules; reference will be made to the original plat for all descriptions and areas of the subdivisions shown thereon, except as amendments have been found necessary.

All subdivisions shown on the original plat remain undisturbed for position, but where same are invaded by lakes not shown, or improperly shown upon the original plat, the areas are shown in two parts: "A" denoting land area, and "B" water area for each 10 acre, or fractional 10 acre subdivision, as exhibited upon the "Supplemental Diagrams". These areas are computed proportionally, according to the total areas of the original subdivisions.

Lot numbers and areas are shown for each 10 acre or fractional 10 acre subdivision of lands found to have been in place at the time of the original survey, erroneously omitted therefrom, and heretofore represented as water surface on the approved plat. In these cases riparian rights do not attach to the lands in front of the original meander line as under the usual doctrine. Where necessary, the original meander line has been reestablished as a fixed boundary of the subdivisions shown on the original plat.

Crews Lake is not shown upon the original plat. Childs, Stearns and Sirena Lakes are found to be out of position with reference to the record of the original survey.
