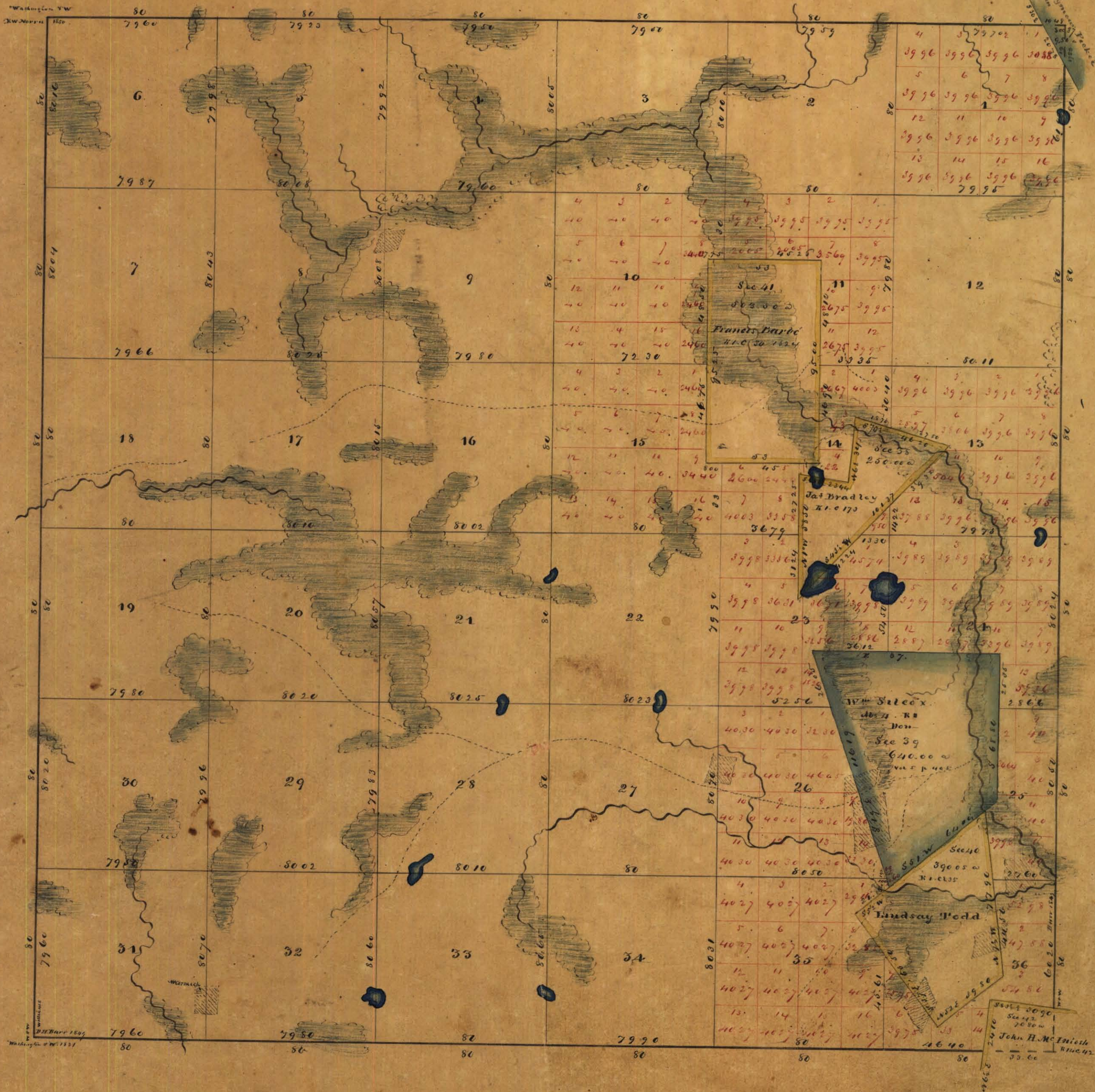

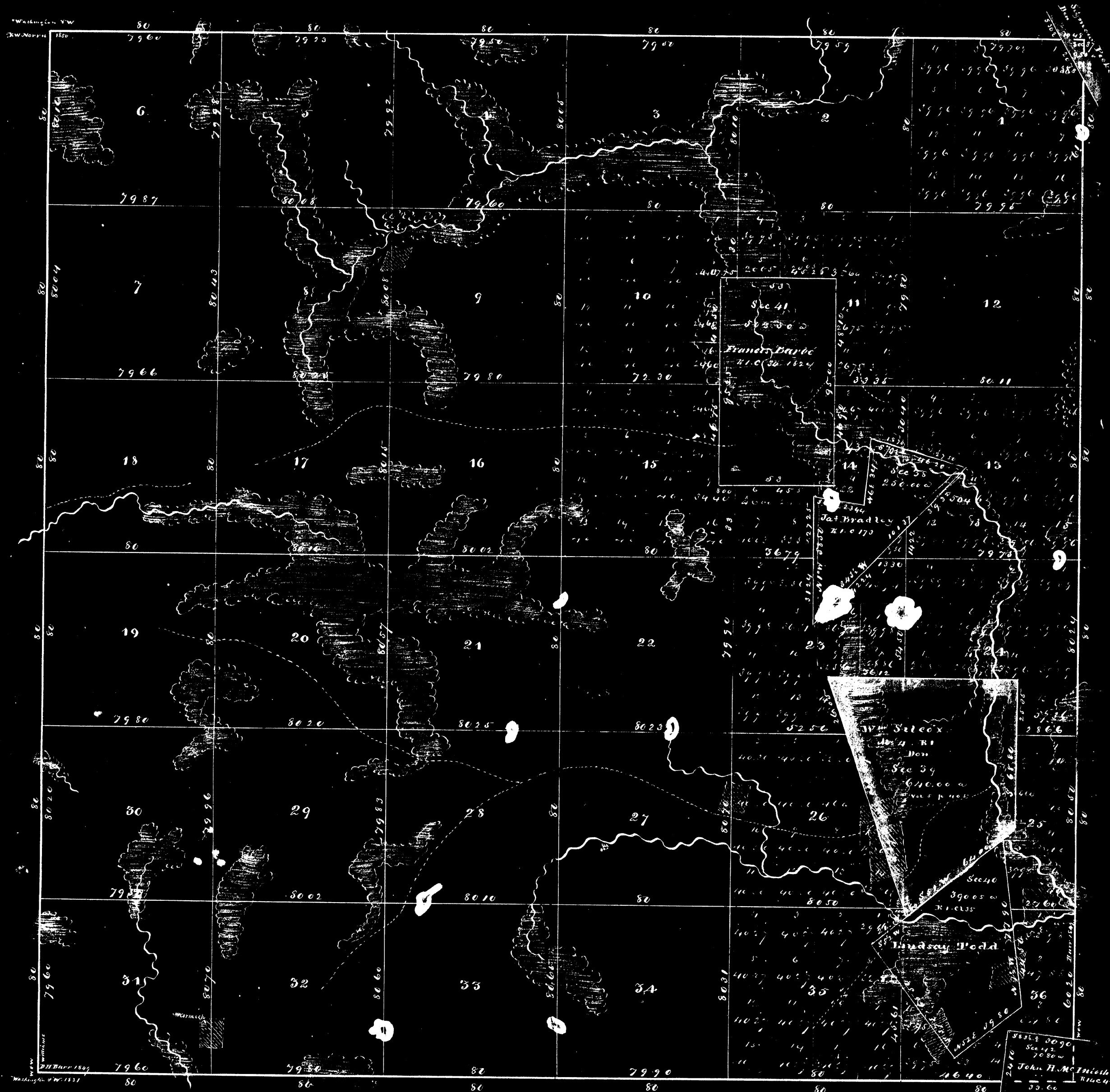

Trustees met in Executive Office.

Governor, Attorney-General and Treasurer, present.

The report of the Commissioner of Agriculture to the effect that the Lot No.1, of Sec.35, T 2 S. R 25 E., and set of set or set of lot 8 of Sec.1, T 2 S. R 20 E., and set of set Sec.9, T 2 S. R 21 E., lie within six mile limit of the old Florida Atlantic and Gulf Central Railroad, and the further fact that said lands are claimed by parties holding through the original grantees of said company; The Trustees do not assert claim to said lands but consider them to have been granted said Florida Atlantic and Gulf Central Railroad, under act of the legislature approved January 6, 1855, granting six mile limit swamp lands.
